## Our Mission

Through partnerships, we focus on breaking the cycle of poverty and violence by providing values-based education, quality health and nutrition and caring personal support.

## Our Roots

In 1991, a small group of Colombian women gathered, concerned by the dire situation of displaced children in Colombia, who lacked education, family, love and future prospects. Through events, funds were raised and sent to various charities in Colombia.

Over the years the organization grew and in 2005, *The Canadian Colombian Children's Organization* received charitable status. Significant progress has been made since 2005 thanks to the support of countless volunteers, corporate sponsors and generous donors.

## Our Current Projects

### **Nazareth School and Orphanage**

For the past fourteen years, "The CCCO" has been helping Nazareth School & Orphanage. With the support of Canadians, we have been able to keep Nazareth open by providing nutrition, health and education to the children.

Several children under their care have already graduated from High School, and have been given the opportunity to be placed in a Technical/Trades School in Bogotá. Once they complete this program, they are guaranteed a job in their trade.

### **Santa Ana**

For the last two years, "The CCCO" has been providing bursaries, registration fees and school supplies for several girls.

By providing basic health care support, the CCCO meets its objective of ensuring the girls meet their basic health needs to promote healthy development and become active members of their community.

### **FundaMAS -**

### **Fundación de Misericordia, Amor y Servicio**

This foundation was established in 1991. The homes created by this Foundation provide the basic needs for the children as well as education from pre-school to the end of high-school graduation. This opens doors to higher education.

The CCCO has been supporting them since 2011 through projects that meet the needs of their children in the areas of nutrition, health and education.

## A Future Filled with Hope

We strongly believe in providing opportunities for kids to develop into self-sufficient adults and contributing members to society. This can break the vicious cycle of poverty and create a stronger Colombia.

### Our Strategic Plan includes:

- Continue to support our current projects,
  - through education resource, nutritional and health support;
  - by providing personal support so children will graduate from high school; and
  - by providing bursaries for post secondary school including apprenticeship opportunities.
- Research and support other projects where Canadians may be able to help children in need in Colombia.
- Pilot outreach project for mothers to increase their ability to provide for the needs of their children.
